### Delphi

Delphi is famous as the ancient sacred site which grew rich as the residence of Pythia and the Oracle, who was consulted on important decisions in the ancient world.

The ancient Greeks considered Delphi to be the centre of the world, as is made clear on the monument of the Omphalos of Delphi. It is located in a spectacular location on the southwestern



slope of Mount Parnassus overlooking the coastal plain to the south and the valley of Phocis.

The company in Duisburg-Rheinhausen has been offering training courses in the technical and commercial sectors for many years. In April, TÜV NORD Bildung opened a second training centre in the heart of the city, close to Duisburg's inner harbour. Here, on a site measuring roughly 1,000 m², women and men acquire qualifications in health care and nursing or are trained up as engine drivers. In a driving simulator complete with cockpit and large screen, the prospective driver can practise by driving a virtual train, braking, accelerating and monitoring the proper operation of the engines as they would in real life. About 100 women and men participate every day in the various training courses on offer in the new training centre.
