Entry Requirements	A good standard of written English. If you have achieved Unit NGC1 in previous 5 Years, you are exempt from taking this unit again when completing additional Certificate qualifications.	
Certification	Requirement	Units NGC1, GC2 and NCC1 are each assessed by a 2 hour examination. Units GC3 and NCC2 are assessed by a practical assessment of a workplace which takes around half a day. A complete NEBOSH Certificate qualification assessment is therefore two written examinations and a practical assessment.
	Dates	Exams are held in March, June, September and December each year.
	UK Venues	Croydon and Chesterfield, or other UK locations including in-house by special arrangement
Continuing Professional Development	Successful completion of any NEBOSH Certificate course meets the academic requirement for Technician status with IOSH (Tech.IOSH) and Associate Membership of the IIRSM (AIIRSM). A NEBOSH Certificate also provides the perfect grounding to progress on to the NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety, which is the qualification for those looking to become a health and safety specialist.
