

ANNEXURE 2**CONDITION FOR USE OF ASSERTION STATEMENT**

- a) The client can only use the GHG assertion for the applied boundary. The client shall not make any statement regarding the assertion that TUV India may consider misleading or unauthorized.
- b) The assertion (along with the reference to the standard) shall be used to refer the status of the client and in conjunction with name of the organization.
- c) The assertion shall not be used in any way that misleads the reader about the verification status of the organization
- d) The extract or full reproduction of assertion shall not be used on the product packaging, product, labels, publicity material, written announcements, Test Reports, Inspection Certificates, Calibration Certificates, etc, or in any other way that may suggest that the TUV India has certified or approved any product or service of the organization or in any other misleading manner.
- g) The client shall not allow its certification status to be used to imply that a product, process, service or person is approved by the certification body.
- h) The issuance of the assertion does not entitle client to use of logo displayed on vehicles, publicity material like part of a large advertisement or stationery or visiting cards or any other media.
