International Quality Managers, PCL-C28 in Germany, Auditors, Admin Staff

Situation

Revised International Standard ISO/IEC 27001 was published in October 2022.
IAF published transition instructions in IAF document IAF MD 26:2022 in February 2023.
DAkkS published detailed transition instruction (in German language) on 01.01.2023.

Basic points

All DIN EN ISO/IEC 27001:2017 (including ISO/IEC 27001:2013) certifications shall expire or be withdrawn at the end of the transition period.	Expiry date shall be limited to end of transition period: Valid until 2025-10-31 completed by following addition (until xxxx-xx-xx in case of migration to ISO/IEC 27001:2022)
CABs shall complete the transition with ABs for ISO/IEC 27001:2022 within 12 months from the last day of the month of publication of the revised standard.	Transition of accreditation to ISO/IEC 27001:2022 completed latest until 31.10.2023
CABs shall cease conducting initial certification audits and recertification audits to ISO/IEC 27001:2013 18 months from the last day of the month of publication of the revised standard.	Any initial certification audit and recertification audit starting 01.05.2024 or later shall be performed basing on ISO/IEC 27001:2022. For initial audits: starting date is first day of audit stage 1.
Completion	After 31.10.2025 any valid certificate shall be based on ISO/IEC 27001:2022 exclusively.

Completed: Client Information

You will find a “Client Information” as separate document.

This document (or its contents) is used to inform certified clients (as well as International Quality Managers, PCL-C28, auditors and admin staff) about relevant aspects of transition briefly.

Completed: Transition Instruction

You will find a “Transition Instruction” (document “A50AA01 - ISO 27001”) as separate document.

This document (or its contents) shall be used to inform International Quality Managers, PCL-C28, auditors and admin staff about relevant aspects of transition in more detail. The document “A50AA01 - ISO 27001” will also be uploaded to directory (A50) in “TIC-Services” after DAkkS approval.

Next steps:

- Finalizing transition plan
- Limitation of appointment of auditors qualified for ISO/IEC 27001:2013 until 31.10.2025 - if not upgraded before
- Modification of certificate template as described and approval of DAkkS, and application for any certificate for ISO/IEC 27001:2013 (re-)issued and expiring regularly after 31.10.2025

- Addition of new version of TP: xx1214 for Revision ISO/IEC 27001:2022 to be used in ZA (ATEA) to identify audits following new edition and transition audits.
