TÜV UK does not allow commercial, financial or other pressures to compromise impartiality.

The basis for the appraisal, auditing, certification, inspection, monitoring and testing as laid down in the company statutes are the relevant regulations, laws and ordinances as well as national and international standards and internal company standards.

TÜV UK understands the importance of impartiality in carrying out its certification activities, manages conflict of interest and ensures the objectivity of its certification activities.
